

**RAISIN REGION CONSERVATION AUTHORITY
Watershed Planner/Regulations Officer**

The Raisin Region Conservation Authority (RRCA) requires a Watershed Planner/Regulations Officer for an anticipated 12-month contract (maternity leave coverage) commencing in March 2010. The successful candidate will be responsible for municipal plan input and review as it relates to the Conservation Authority land use planning program, as well as the administration, implementation and enforcement of environmental policies and regulations such as O. Reg. 175/06, Development, Interference with Wetlands and Alterations to Shorelines and Watercourses.

Qualifications:

- Post secondary education in environmental studies/science, resource management, planning, geography or closely related discipline.
- Strong interpersonal, oral and written communication skills.
- Knowledge of natural resource management and the land use planning process.
- Knowledge of applicable environmental regulations, policies and legislation.
- Knowledge of Microsoft Word/ Outlook/PowerPoint, geographic information systems and the interpretation of maps and aerial photographs.
- A valid Ontario driver's license.

Key Responsibilities

- Review site-specific land use planning applications and prepare timely responses to municipalities that outline natural hazard, natural heritage and water quality issues as listed in the Provincial Policy Statement.
- Review and prepare input to municipal planning documents.
- Liaise with provincial, federal and municipal stakeholders regarding legislation, policies, regulations and guidelines to ensure consistency and adherence for public health and safety.
- Respond to legal inquiries, property inquiries, request for information pertaining to plan review, regulations and fish habitat.
- Read, analyze, evaluate technical submissions and work with technical staff at the RRCA in a team environment.
- Review, issue and enforce permits under the Section 28 of the Conservation Authorities Act.
- Prepare reports and communications and give presentations to Authority Boards, interest groups and the public.
- Participate in court and municipal board hearings.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
